Our Alpinols 3% CBD oil has been specifically formulated for the needs of cats. CBD has a positive effect on cats and helps with pain, anxiety, loss of appetite, inflammation, cancer and epilepsy. Healthy cats also benefit from the effects of CBD: anxiety and aggression are reduced, eating behaviour can improve and the animal benefits from a healthy digestion and shiny fur.

- **THC free:** Cats are much more sensitive to THC than humans or dogs because of their nature and body mass.
- **Without Terpenes:** Terpenes are very difficult for cats to break down and may cause discomfort, liver and kidney damage. In the worst case, they can lead to organ failure and death.



Important: Only use CBD oils suitable for cats

The endocannabinoid system and anatomy of a cat and a human are very different. Animals are more sensitive to THC than humans. Therefore, you should only give your cat CBD oils that are specially formulated for cats. As a manufacturer of CBD oils for cats, we take care to produce products without THC. Every batch is tested in an independent laboratory, guaranteeing that the THC content is always below the detection limit.

Terpenes can be intolerable for cats

Terpenes are natural molecules that we perceive as aroma substances. When we recognise the aromatic scent of citrus, terpenes are always involved. Essential oils contain large amounts of terpenes. Hemp extract is also rich in terpenes, which have many positive and health-promoting properties for us humans. Many manufacturers of CBD products therefore strive to reflect the full spectrum of terpenes in their essences. Whilst this is great for humans—the same does not apply for cats. In contrast to humans and dogs, cats cannot break down terpenes or can do so only after a long time. This is why we recommend products from safe production and with the appropriate quality and certification for long-term treatments.

Dosage

The best dose of CBD for your cat will depend on body weight, symptoms, degree of discomfort, personal body chemistry and tolerance for CBD. Most cat owners have found an effective dose of 0.3mg CBD or more for each pound of their cat's body weight.

Our 3% CBD contains 1.5mg per drop

CBD is very safe and well tolerated in cats. So if you find that this initial dose is not effective, you are welcome to increase it. Just do this little by little to give your cat a pleasant experience. These are general dosage guidelines. Your vet may give you specific dosage recommendations.

Your cat's cannabidiol receptors

The body's own cannabinoid receptors bind CBD to themselves, so that the analgesic, anti-inflammatory, calming, antipsychotic and anxiety-relieving effect can fully unfold. Thanks to its antioxidant properties, cannabidiol can even protect cells and genetic material from negative influences. Studies on cells show that cannabidiol can inhibit the growth of cancer cells.



- CB1:** Receptors occur predominantly in the brain and nervous system
- CB2:** Receptors occur predominantly in immune cells and peripheral organs
